#### Why Rock by Rock?

A Rock by Rock project is an interdisciplinary unit with a set of aligned lessons that build towards a real-world take-action project. We develop literacy skills through science and social studies topics and content. This all culminates in displaying what they have learned through a real world 21st century process and product. We combine the best of online and hands-on learning to give kids an authentic, interdisciplinary, multimodal learning experience. Our projects prepare kids for the real-world. They solve real, complex problems and apply skills from reading, writing, science, and SEL skills together in real ways. Each project meets a set of core learning goals and follows a learning journey designed to meet those goals.

## **Our Learning Goals**

All of our projects are designed to help students meet a range of mission critical life outcomes.

- 1. **Spark** a curiosity and passion for learning.
- 2. **Meet standards** in an authentic, interdisciplinary way.
- 3. **Engage** in intellectual challenge.
- 4. **Experience relevant, authentic and real-world experts** to inspire and inform.
- 5. **Exercise choice** and decision making.
- 6. **Share** learning and ideas with the world.
- 7. Grow and reflect on key life habits and SEL skills.

## **Our Learning Journey**

All of our projects follow a problem-solving based learning journey.

- 1. **Invest**: Invest students in their mission / project.
- 2. **Discuss:** Discuss and make meaning of one key SEL / life habit students will use throughout the project.
- 3. **Explore**: Learn and grapple with the core STEAM content students need to develop a real-world solution through text, video, interactive and hands-on learning, discussion, writing and debate.
- 4. **Take Action:** Complete a project that empowers students to make real-change in the world.
- 5. **Share**: Enlist others to work towards or rally around student's take action project / solution .
- 6. **Reflect**: Reflect on what students learned about themselves as leaders and how they grew in their life habits.
