Each Rock by Rock project has a set of materials you and your child will use to successfully complete the project. This checklist was designed to help you get started with each project.

<input type="checkbox"/>	1	Select Your Project	Your first step: is to decide which project you want to complete. The project page for each project has links to all the materials below. For easy reference, you can save your project to your dashboard by clicking on the star icon on the project page.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	Download Educators Guide	Your first project: Read the first 6-8 pages of the educator guide. It provides an overview of how projects are structured. Ongoing: Skim the educator guide to understand the arc of the project and how to lead your class through a project..	
<input type="checkbox"/>	3	Download Hands-on Materials List	Download the material list. You can prep the materials up front at the start of the project or organize the materials for each hands-on activity as you go. If you don't have some of the materials, feel free to substitute for something similar. The goal is the learning, not the exact materials.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	4	Download Student Mission Log & Other Printed Materials	Each project has a student Mission Log. K-2: Students will need you to print the Mission Log so they can write, print, cut and make. For K-2, you will also need to print the literacy lessons. Everything else is optional depending on what format you like best. 3-5: You can print the Mission Log for your student or share it digitally. If you share digitally, you may still need to print some key pages to support the hands-on lessons.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	5	Generate Student Link	Generate a link. To share online content with students, generate a link to the desired project by clicking on the link icon. Share that link with students.
