Creativity Mind Maps



Making Mind Maps

us write all our ideas down. That way, when you are done making a mind map, you can look at it again and again. Changemakers can use mind maps to help them come up with new ideas or solve problems.

The Mind Map Checklist

You can make a mind map in many different ways. Afterall, mind maps help changemakers be creative.

Here are some tips from other changemakers to help make a strong mind map.

Criteria for an effective Mind Map
Check off each item to ensure you have a strong mindmap.
Probelm in the Middle: Does your middle circle have a clear problem?
Draw many branches off the cirlce.
Each branch has more than one word or idea. Think BIG!
Draw lines from solutions to the problem.
Use the whole paper! Don't leave white space. Keep going until you run out of room for your ideas. The more you can think of the better.
No ideas are bad. Put all your ideas on paper. You never know which one will be the best.
