

About: See, Think, Wonder can be used daily or weekly to build inquiry skills. Students observe an image or short video and answer the questions:

- What do you see?
- What do you think?
- What do you wonder?

Explain before starting students should only state what they can see when answering the first question. When answering what they think, students can make assumptions about what can be seen. When answering what they wonder, students are encouraged to create responses about what can't be seen or may happen next.
