About: When you are working with developing readers, a word wall can be a great way remind kids of words they've learned. Kids can use the wall as a reference to help when reading and use words on the wall in their writing.

Directions:

- 1. Make:** Find a space where you can hang words or find a board you can take out and display during reading lessons. (Keep the board out during other subjects to help kids use their new words throughout the day.)
- 2. Add:** Add new words each week to the wall. Use the templates in this resource of make your own.
- 3. Use:** Celebrate whenever you find a vocabulary word in a text or use it in writing or conversation.

 - a. Write the word
 - b. Write the word with a picture as a reminder.
